SEMINAR A

Joint Attention and Autism Spectrum Disorder

This workshop will include a discussion of how parents and educators can establish joint attention with children who are not developing this skill naturally. It will help parents and educators understand how to get children to start requesting the things they want so that they may build functional language skills and decrease the possibility for development of problem behavior. Using Visual Supports to Maximize Learning and Independence

Many children with autism benefit greatly from visual supports in a number of ways. Children of all ages and skill levels can use visual supports to help them understand and follow instructions, stay on task, schedule daily activities, and self monitor behavior. This workshop will introduce the concept of using visual supports and give parents and educators practical ideas based on individual need.
